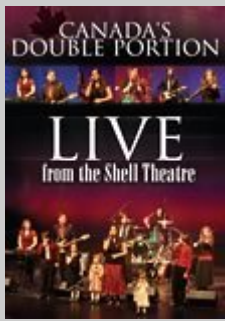

Bronson's middle name is Murray after Uncle Murray who never married. He was 82 years old, a wonderful man of God and well respected in the Kingsway Foursquare Church.

On the last weekend of June we ministered at Bethel Temple in Kelvington, SK and at First Baptist Church in Humboldt. We met an outreach group in Humboldt from Paradise, Texas who were helping with the town's Summer Sizzler event.

The boy's youth band is continuing to get opportunities to minister. They opened for MANIFEST in Lloydminster, SK in May and then did a youth night with the Hunters at the Heritage Gospel Jamboree. They also helped lead worship at the Shiloh Youth Ranch at the end of June.
